## Guidelines for Vinyl Boat Lift/Slip Roof

ALL Vinyl Boat Lift/Slip Roof (formerly called covers)applications <u>MUST RECEIVE "FINAL"</u> Approval by the RVPOA Architectural Review Board (ARB) <u>PRIOR TO THE</u> commencement of construction. The applicant or contractor <u>MUST</u> provide the ARB with proof of compliance with ALL applicable federal, state, regional and local permitting agencies, <u>OR PROVIDE WRITTEN</u> <u>EXEMPTION FROM SUCH.</u> The approved final signed copy of the permit shall be provided to the ARB when the construction is completed, as well as the electrical inspection within said permit if included.

## **Specific Requirements**

- The structure must meet all applicable set-back requirements per local ordinances
- Height Requirements Maximum of 17' from HMWL to roof peak.
- Maximum length 36'
- Maximum Width 16'
- NO RETRACTABLE ROOFS ALLOWED
- Material Used: Minimum requirements-Solid Aluminum I-Beam Construction with a Patio 500 Vinyl PVC top, three layers thick
- Allowed Colors:
  - 508 Black

546 Stone Grey

522 Beige

NOTE: These are from the Trivantage Patio 500 color charts. The ARB committee can accept comparable colors if the ARB is provided with samples/color charts to compare.

- Profile: Canopy Only
- No more than 2' overhang on any side
- Opposing sides must all be same size (no extra overhang or gable cutouts)
- Lighting: Only downlighting allowed
  - o No lighting of any area outside the boat roof (such as spotlights or motion lights that shine out/or past the structure.
- No attachments, extensions, ladders, any sides even if permeable or other appurtenances may be added to the boat roof at any time.
- Must be maintained in like-new condition.

It is recommended that owners follow the manufacturer's recommendations regarding weather-related vinyl boat roof removals.
